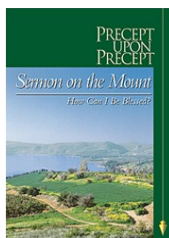
James— Mercy Triumphs (Beth Moore)

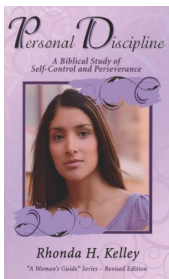


Sermon on the Mount: How Can I Be Blessed? (Kay Arthur)

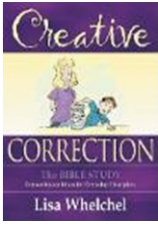


Brave: Honest Questions Women Ask (Angela Thomas)

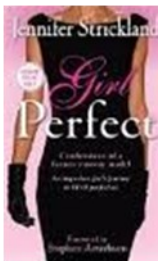


One in a Million (Priscilla Shirer)

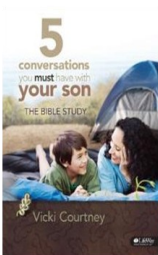


Girl Perfect (Jennifer Strickland)
